TERMINAL CITY ROLLERGIRLS PHOTOGRAPHY RULES:

Dear Photographer,

You'll have access to photograph from the following areas:

- the general floor area where the skaters and refs are, including the 'sit at your own risk' area
- the areas at the far ends of each of the two players' benches
- the area in between the two players benches
- the built-in hockey benches on the other side of the floor, across from the derby players' benches (depending on the venue, there may not be hockey benches across from the derby skaters' benches)
- anywhere else the public is allowed

You may NOT shoot in the following areas:

- on the track itself
- inside the track where the refs are
- within the 10-foot safety zone bordering the outside of the track
- the dressing rooms

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- 1) You may only walk through the 10-foot safety zone and in front of the players' benches in between jams. When game play is in action, the 10-foot safety zone is out of bounds, as is the area in front of the players' benches.
- 2) The area in front of the penalty box is a dangerous and high-traffic zone. Please be extra cautious and alert when walking in front of this area as skaters are coming and going at any time. It's always best to walk behind the penalty box, rather than in front.
- 3) Photographers may NOT shoot, or stand, in front of the scorekeepers table at any time. You may only pass through here when moving from one spot of the arena to another. You may, however, crouch down in front of the table to shoot.
- 4) Please keep in mind that the refs, officials and skaters always have the right of way. If a skater/ref/official is standing right in front of you when you're shooting, you must move so that they are not in front of you. You should never ask a skater/ref/official to move out of your way.

5) TCRG is not responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged camera gear. Just like any other sporting event, photographers shoot at their own risk and are responsible for any damage that may happen to his/her gear.

6) Photographers are not allowed to bring an 'assistant'. If you have someone who normally helps you at photo shoots, he/she will not be allowed in for free — he/she must pay for a ticket to get in to the event. In addition he/she will not be granted the same floor access as you.

7) Photographers are not to use photos from the event depicting accidental nudity for any purpose. TCRG reserves the right to demand that any offending photo be taken down and not be further published.
